

## top tips for maintaining your C A L I F O N T

- Use an anti-freezing plug to fully drain the califont for cold nights or when going away for a period of time. This prevents the water turning into ice which can crack/damage the valves and heater exchanger; a pricey replacement!
- Always clear out any spider webs or debris!
- Install a louvered cover (using non-inflammable/non-combustible materials) over to the top of the califont with min clearance of 300mm; don't box the califont up; leave the front and bottom open for air circulation.
- Always have a licensed gas technician to install your califont, otherwise the warranty and/or insurance may be void!
- Always have spare size D batteries near by!
